Following are three different sample scopes & sequences for 6th through 8th grade students based on when your family starts with Homeschool Connections.

If you choose live, interactive courses you may need to substitute other courses for the ones listed below as some courses are not offered every semester and new ones are always being created. Many families do a combination of recorded and live courses.

Remember, these are only suggestions. We offer many other courses if you'd like to make additions or substitutions. You can easily make adjustments to fit your family dynamic, special needs, and your child's academic level. It is also likely you will want to substitute a few subjects with courses using other resources such as a local co-op, favorite program, or family unit study.

Some families choose to rearrange courses so one or two subjects are taught in the summer, lightening up the fall and spring workload for outside activities. This way, learning stays alive year round while making time for special interests, clubs, and sports.
