

## **Requirements and Benefits of the Homeschool Connections Advanced College Credit Partnership with Benedictine College (BC)**

\*\*\*Note: Recorded courses are not eligible for college credit.

### **Student requirements:**

- Enroll in an eligible Homeschool Connections course at <https://caravel.homeschoolconnections.com/catalog>
- The cost is \$100 per credit hour, in addition to normal Homeschool Connections fees paid at registration. Most courses are 3 credit hours for the two semesters, costing \$300. Students must register for both Fall and Spring semesters.
- Must be a high school junior or senior.
- We recommend having at least a 2.4 cumulative GPA for best chance of success.
- Homeschool Connections students will register for a college credit course (both semesters) through the HSC course registration platform. HSC course fees are paid at registration and subject to the HSC refund policy.
- Parents will receive an electronic enrollment form from HSC for the college credit option within one week of the course start date. Student information will be passed through to Benedictine College.
- HSC will bill parents for Benedictine’s fee of \$300 in September, subject to the BC refund policy (below).
- Homeschool Connections will collect all registration information and submit the information to the Benedictine registrar.

### **College Credit withdrawal and refund policy**

- The student may attend two classes and still be eligible for a full refund from Benedictine College. Students are no longer eligible for a refund after the third class begins. (Please see the Parent Handbook for the HSC refund policy, which is separate from the BC policy.)
- Written notification to Homeschool Connections is required for withdrawal from the Benedictine program.
- Students earning below a C- will not receive credit for the Advanced College Credit course from Benedictine College. The Benedictine College transcript will list “No Credit.”

### **Student benefits:**

- An official Benedictine transcript for the course will be accessible through [GetMyTranscript.com](https://getmytranscript.com) with the BC student ID received from the HSC instructor.
- Increase confidence by gaining experience managing college level courses.
- High school juniors and seniors can get a jump start on their college degree.
- Take advantage of a reduced per-credit-hour cost for college credits.
